The matter of establishing and changing Election Precincts in said County and the places of voting therein coming on to be considered and the Court being satisfied that three months notice has been given by posting written notice at the Court House door in said County that said matters would be considered and acted upon at this time of the Court and that that more than thirty days notice is known before any election will be held in said County thereupon the Court proceed to establish Election Precincts in said County and places of voting therein as follows

Precinct No 1 Commencing at the North East corner of the County thence west to the range line between 13 and 14 thence south to the Township line between 22 & 23 thence east to Yellow leaf Creek down said creek to Coosa River thence up said River to place of beginning Voting Places thence across Road and Shaders Hills

Precinct No 2 Commencing at the North West corner of Precinct No 1 thence west to the North West corner of the County thence south to the Township line between 22 & 23 thence east along said Township

line to the range line between 13 & 14 thence North on said line to the beginning Voting place at Providence Church

Precinct No 3 commencing at the South East corner of Precinct No 2 thence west to the County line south along said line to Township line between 21 & 22 thence west to the Range line between 12 & 13 to the Mountgomery Road thence east along said road to where it crosses the Range line between 12 and 13 thence down said Range line to the North East corner of Section 19 Township 22 R 13 thence East to Range line between 13 & 14 thence north along said line to the beginning Voting place of voting to be at Benson
