Header	State of Alabama; Chilton County. Commissioners Court - Regular Term, November 4th 1878. Present and presiding: H. J. Callen, Judge of Probate. Commissioners present: D. A. White and Moses Robinson.
Commissioners	It is ordered by the Court that the order heretofore made by this Court at the August Term thereof in reference to the compromise of the taxes due from the South and North Alabama Rail Road Company for the years 1875 was and is hereby extended; that said order shall be a full and complete discharge of said Rail Road Company for all taxes due from said Rail Road Company prior to the tax year A.D. 1878.
Railroad taxes	It is further ordered by the Court that the receipt given by J. W. Parish, Treasurer of said county, to said Rail Road Company for the sum of fifteen hundred dollars shall be a full and complete discharge of said Rail Road Company for all taxes due the County of Chilton from said Company prior to the tax year A.D. 1878.

\$67.00 - J. W. Dunlap, Sheriff	It is ordered by the Court that James W. Dunlap, Sheriff of said County, be, and he is hereby, allowed his warrant on the County Treasurer for the sum of sixty-seven dollars for attending on the Circuit Court & County Court and road service for the year 1878.
\$70.75 - H. J. Callen, Judge Book Page 4	It is ordered by the Court that H. J. Callen, Judge of Probate, be, and he is hereby, allowed his warrant on the County Treasurer for the sum of seventy & 75/100 dollars for ex-officio services for the 4th quarter 1878.

\$119.00 - H. J. Callen	It is ordered by the Court that H. J. Callen be, and he is hereby, allowed his warrant on the County Treasurer for the sum of one hundred and nineteen dollars for making abstract for Auditor & Collector, examining revenue books, reporting thirteen road hands and two cases in the County Court.
Establish a public road - Connell Road	It is ordered by the Court that there be a public road established in said County to be called the Connell Road, to begin at a point at or near three hundred yards west of William Connell and to intersect the road leading from Clanton to Calera at mims x Roads. It is further ordered that William Connell, Peter Nix, D. H. Mullins, J. J. Honeycutt, William Robinson, Pink Robinson and Robert Barrett be appointed a jury of review to view and chart out said road and report thereon at the next term of this Court.
Establish a public road - Kelly & Mullins Road	It is ordered by the Court that there be a public road established in said County to be called the Kelly & Mullins Road, to leave the Adams Ferry Road at or near John Kelly and to intersect the Montgomery & Columbiana Road at or near A. W. Mullins. It is further ordered that Alvie Mullins, W. J. Marcus, John Kelly, Louis Littleton, Frank Kelly, James Jones, J. H. Vines and Mac Johnson be appointed a jury of review to mark out said road and report thereon at the next term of this Court.
\$4.00 - H. J. Callen Book Page 5	It is ordered by the Court that H. J. Callen, Judge of Probate, be and he is hereby allowed his warrant on the County Treasurer for the sum of four dollars for presiding at November term Commissioners Court [entry continues].
