Insolvencies on Poll Tax - \$325.00

Errors on Poll Tax - \$51.00

Total - \$376.00

Errors on Real estate: State Tax \$40.80; County Tax \$31.25

Errors on Personal property: State Tax \$8.14; County Tax \$6.27

Insolvencies on Personal property: State Tax \$23.22; County Tax \$17.84

Total State Tax - \$72.16

Total County Tax - \$55.36

And the Court having inspected the same find the same correct as reported. It is therefore ordered by the Court that R. M. Honeycutt, Tax Collector as aforesaid, be and he is hereby allowed a credit for the amounts as the same stands stated.
