MAIN TEXT: And now comes R. M. Honeycutt, Tax Collector of said County, and presents to the Court his list of errors and insolvencies in manner and form as prescribed by law for the tax year 1882. And it appearing from the inspection of said report that R. M. Honeycutt said Tax Collector is entitled to the following credits on the account of errors and insolvencies of poll tax, personal property and real estate as follows: Errors on Poll Tax \$40.50; Insolvencies on Poll Tax \$503.50; Total \$544.00. Errors on Real Estate: State Tax \$9.33, County Tax \$8.74, Total \$18.07. Errors on personal property: State Tax \$.30, County Tax \$.24, Total \$.54. Insolvencies on personal property: State Tax \$23.69, County Tax \$15.79, Total \$44.48. Totals: State Tax \$36.22; County Tax \$22.25. Judge of Probate, H. J.
