When the following orders and proceedings were made and entered in the minutes:

Whereas at the August Term of this Court, A.D. 1882, the following order was entered in its minutes viz. It is ordered by the Court that there be assessed and collected for County purposes for the Tax year 1882 (4%) of one percent four tenths of one percent on each one hundred dollars worth of real and personal part thereof of Real and Personal property assessed for State Tax during the year 1882 in the County of Shelby in said State. It is further ordered by the Court that the Judge of Probate be and he is hereby required to collect of all license issues under the revenue laws of the State of Alabama from year until the August Term of this Court 1883 the sum of one half of one percent on all State Taxes so collected. And Whereas it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the latter part of the foregoing order to wit that portion fixing the amount to be collected on all license for County purposes issued under the revenue laws of this State is unknown as the same stands stated and recorded in the minutes and proceedings of this Court bearing date August 14th 1882

It is therefore Ordered by the Court that said Order as above set forth be amended *more or less* so as to read as follows. It is ordered by the Court that there be assessed and collected for County purposes for the Tax year 1882 (4%) of one percent on each one hundred dollars worth of real and personal part thereof of the Valuation of Real and Personal property assessed for State Tax during the year 1882 in the County of Shelby in said State. It is further ordered by the Court that the Judge of Probate be and he is hereby required to collect on all license issued under the revenue laws of the State of Alabama from year until the August Term of this Court 1883 the sum of 4 1/2 percent of the amount of State License

Whereas at the August Term of this Court
A.D. 1853 the following order was entered in
the Records, viz. It is ordered by the Court
that there shall be assessed and collected a
tax of 3/10 of one percent for County purposes on all
property real and personal, valued for the
State in the Tax year 1853 and no more. It is
further ordered by the Court that the Judge of
Probate do and he is hereby is quired to collect
on all debts issued for use under the revenue
laws of this State the sum of one half of one
cent in the dollar raised by the State for said
purpose for County purposes.

And that the payment to the satisfaction of the
Court of the latter part of the foregoing order to
wit that portion fixing the amount to be collected
on all debts for County purposes issued under
the revenue laws of this State is an error as
the same stands stated and recorded in the minutes
and proceedings of this Court bearing date August
1853.

It is therefore ordered by the Court
that said order as above set forth be and
the same whereby amended. Wherefore so as to
read as follows. It is ordered by the Court
that there shall be assessed and collected a
tax of 3/10 of one percent for County purposes on
all property real and personal assessed for the
State in the Tax year 1853 and no more.

It is further ordered by the Court, that
the Judge of Probate do and he is hereby
required to collect on all debts
issued under the Revenue laws of the State of
Alabama from now until the August Term of
this Court 1854 the sum of Fifty percent of
the amount of State Tax.

hereby ratified by the Court.
