Regular Term, August 11 1884

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August term 1884	The State of Alabama, Chilton County. Commissioners Court, regular term August 11th A.D. 1884. Present and presiding Hon. H. J. Callen, Judge of Probate; R. C. Lenoir, Buckner Harris, Moses Robertson, and Anderson Baker Sr., commissioners. The Court proceeded to transact such business as was brought before it when the following orders were made and entered in the premises.
