Scoggins land running along the South line of his land to South West corner of said land a distance of 1/4 mile thence to Centreville road distance all about 600 yards.

Fifty percent on licenses	It is ordered by the Court that the Judge of Probate be and he is hereby directed to collect for County purposes on all licenses issued by him under the revenue laws of this State the sum of fifty per cent on the amount collected by the State.
