It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that notice of said application has been given as required by law, it is therefore ordered that Richard Cox, John Parnell, J. W. Broadhead, W. W. Little, John Letcher, O. McGee, J. A. Stephens be appointed as a jury of viewers to view and mark out said road.
Scotland Road	This day came E. J. Coffey and four others, a jury of viewers heretofore appointed of said Court as a jury to view and mark out a new public road commencing about half mile west of Jamison on the Providence road, thence west of Gree Horsely, thence by Green Coffers, thence by Reese Langston's mill, thence to and intersect the Shelby Springs road near Pink Gentry. Reporting that after being sworn that they have viewed and marked out said road as above described and no objections appearing to the opening and establishing of said road, it is therefore ordered that said road be established as a third grade road and shall be known as the Scotland road and that Frank Langston be appointed as overseer to open said road.
